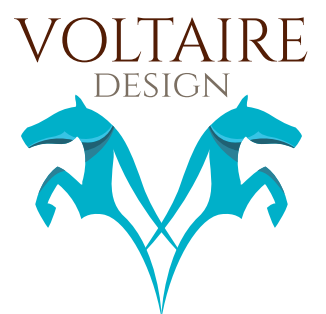

Non-USEF and USHJA members will NOT be charged a Non-Member or Show Pass Fee. USHJA membership at the \$35 level or higher is required ONLY for an individual wishing to earn points toward USHJA-sponsored year-end awards. Hunter championships will be presented in each hunter section with the top four over fences earning under saddle points. Equitation championships will be presented in each equitation section with points counting equally for all classes. Combined section championships will be presented in each combined section with points counting equally for all classes. Ties broken by the most points over fences; if still tied, then most points in the equitation flat class.

pick up their pace and pass through a set of markers to begin the Handy portion of the class. The Handy round will consist of 4-5 fences, where pace, brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Option fences may be used in either round, at the course designer's discretion. This class will be judged by one judge giving one score. Formal attire is requested, but not required.

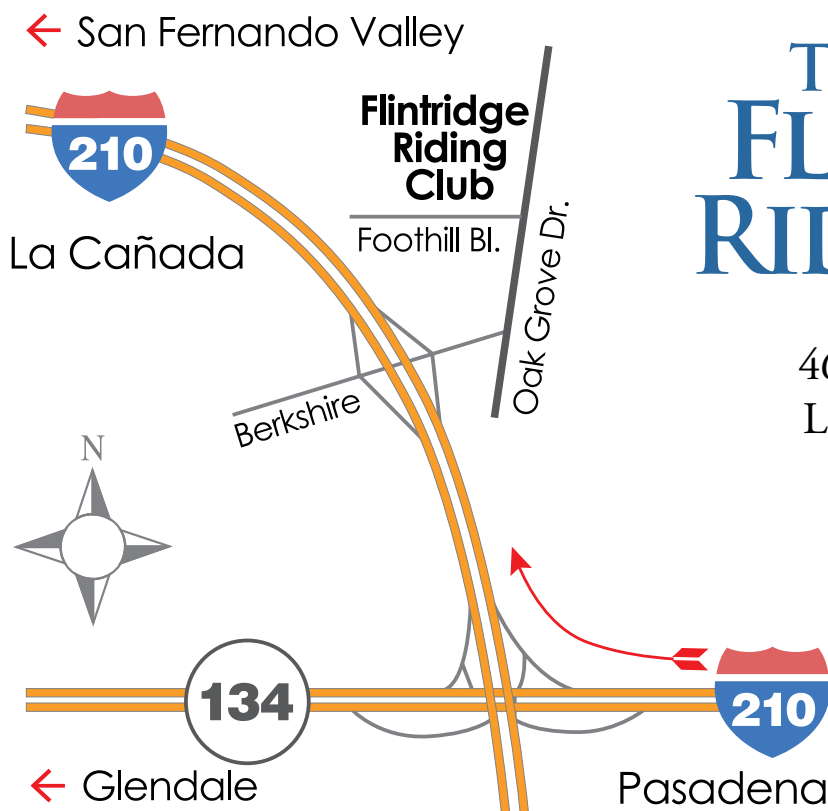
## 412. \$250 LEG UP HUNTER DERBY - 2'

OFFERED AT LA FALL FESTIVAL

Entry Fee: \$65

To be eligible, horses must have competed in at least two classes over fences in any of the Outreach sections at the same show. Riders may not have shown over 2'9" or in the USHJA National Hunter Derby at the same show. Riders may show multiple horses in this class. Open to junior and amateur riders only. Horse and rider combinations to jump a Classic round consisting of 5-6 fences. Directly after the completion of the Classic round, horses will pick up their pace and pass through a set of markers to begin the Handy portion of the class. The Handy round will consist

of 4-5 fences, where pace, brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Option fences may be used in either round, at the course designer's discretion. Two scores will be given by the judging panel, with one score for the Classic round, and one score for the Handy round. The scores will be added together to determine the total score and placement. In the case of a tie, the Handy score will be designated as the tie breaker. Formal attire is requested, but not required.

For the work-off the judges will sit together and give one score. If there is a tie after the work-off, another work-off of just the tied riders will be required. Different work-offs will be required for juniors and seniors.

**SCORING:** Scores from round 1 will be averaged, scores from round 2 will be averaged and averaged with the scores from round 1 to determine the top ten that will return for round 3. To obtain a final score after round 3, the scores from rounds 1, 2 and 3 will be averaged. The score for the work-off will be added to the overall average to determine the winner.

**ORDER OF GO:** Round 1 will be drawn. Round 2 will be the reverse order of Round 1. Round 3 will ride low score to high score from the average score of the first two rounds. The top ten scores, ties for 10th place, and any rider with an average of 80 or above will return for Round 3. 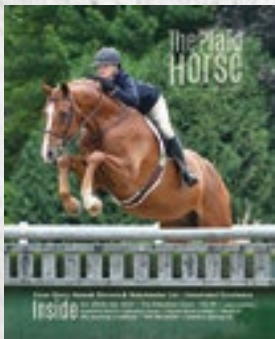

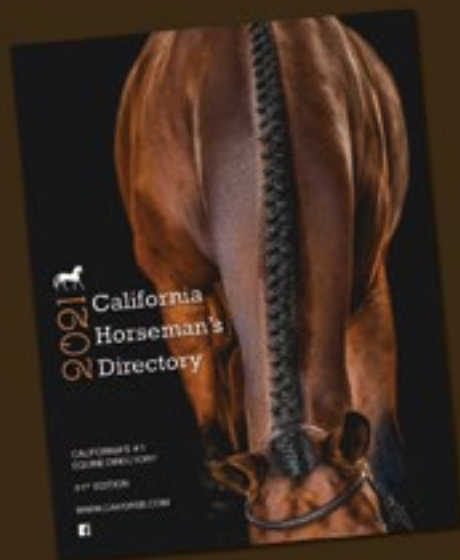



# RULES, REGULATIONS & GENERAL INFORMATION

1. These competitions are governed and approved by the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. To the extent there is a conflict between the prize list and the USEF rules, USEF rules will prevail. Senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**REMINDER:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org).

**2. USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation"). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/ or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of California, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in California State. See GR 908.4. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit

entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In the event of a cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees must be made upon request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.

**USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT:** Effective immediately, all individuals on the property will be required to sign the USEF Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement. The Agreement will be available on our website ([www.westpalmsevents.com](http://www.westpalmsevents.com)) and can be executed and signed electronically.

**3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Horse Show Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Horse Show and its officials, employees, directors, officers, Hansen Dam Horse Park, Los Angeles Equestrian Center, West Palms Event Management, LEG Shows & Events, Huntington Central Park Equestrian Center, Flintridge Riding Club and its Sponsors, etc for any loss or accident to his horse, horses, employees or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

**4. MANAGEMENT:** Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management-their decision to be final. Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate or change judges and officials; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel. Management reserves the right to limit entries in a class. Refused entries will be returned.

**5. ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** By signing the entry blank, the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Loungeur acknowledges that horseback riding, particularly jumping, is a dangerous activity and involves inherent risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases death because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance and expressly assumes all such inherent risks whether identified herein, in the entry blank, or in the Federation Rules and Regulations. A horse, without warning or any

apparent cause, can buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's foot or push a person—all of which may cause the rider or observer to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death. A horse may also become loose and cause injury to an observer or rider or to another horse—a loose horse can run at full gallop in a panic and run into objects or persons or other horses. The Show Ground Facilities are bordered by highways/roads and thus noise from traffic and other sources occurs that can and will cause a horse to unexpectedly spook or react quickly. The Show Ground Facilities contain roads or driveways that are traversed by cars, golf carts, tractors, trailers and heavy equipment all of which may spook a horse. The above warnings and risks are meant as an example of some of the risks that are inherent and may be encountered but it is agreed this is not an exhaustive list and there are numerous additional conditions and/or events that may result in injuries while participating in the Competition and/or being present on the Show Ground Facility.

## 6. THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED FOR EACH ENTRY:

- A. All horses on grounds must be registered on an entry blank including horses not entered in classes. One entry blank per horse.
- B. Entry forms must be complete with owner, riders, trainers and payee information including association membership numbers.
- C. Date of Birth of all minor exhibitors.
- D. Signatures of owner, riders, trainer and parent or guardian of minor exhibitors. Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show, West Palms Event Management, Inc., LEG Shows & Events, Los Angeles Equestrian Center and the Hansen Dam Horse Park and staff harmless for injury to such minor(s).
- E. Entries must be submitted electronically through Equestrian Connect or emailing [ak@westpalmsevents.com](mailto:ak@westpalmsevents.com).
- F. For all horses include Nomination and Stall Fees as a deposit. Make checks payable to West Palms Event Management or complete the credit card information and sign on the entry blank. If credit card information is given, the credit card authorization form must be filled out and accompany the entry.

**7. PAYMENT:** An open check or credit card is required at time of check in before numbers will be issued. See 6F for deposit information. A 3% credit card fee will be applied to all credit card transactions and is nonrefundable once the card has been processed.

**8. REFUNDS:** Request for a refund of the deposit must be in writing and received before the closing date of entries and a \$35.00 fee will be deducted. The nomination and stall fees are not refundable under any condition after the close of entries. Credit Card fees are nonrefundable at any time after the card has been processed.

**9. POST ENTRIES:** Entries received with payment after entries are due but before the Monday of each show will pay a \$75.00 late fee. All entries received at the show will pay a \$150.00 late fee.

**10. ADDS/SCRATCHES:** All adds must be made by 5:00 pm the day prior to each class. No entries will be accepted for a class scheduled on the same day. **In the unusual case the time schedule allows a management approved add the day of a class, the entry fee will be double.** Horses and riders who go in a class without entering will pay a fee of \$50.00. All scratches must be received in the show office before the start of the class in writing to be considered for a refund; scratches via phone call or at the gate will NOT be considered. In divisions that are entered by complete section, no refund will be considered if the horse shows in any class of the division. The only other refunds given will be for cancellation of a class by Management, overpayment of fees, or the rejection of entries because of ineligibility or lack of stall space.

**11. RAIN:** In the event of rain prior to the Show, it is the riders' responsibility to call Show Management to determine whether the show is cancelled.

## 12. RESPONSIBILITY OF PAYMENT OF SERVICES AND SUPPLIES:

All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their animals, agents, or employees, to stalls, buildings and other properties on the Show grounds and shall be billed accordingly. All bills for veterinary, farrier services and feed/bedding are due and payable during the Show. Management reserves the right to deduct any unpaid veterinary, farrier and feed/bedding bills from premium money due the exhibitor. Any exhibitor not meeting his obligations to the official Show Veterinarian, farrier and feed/bedding vendor will be termed an undesirable exhibitor and entries from that exhibitor may not be accepted at subsequent shows.

**13. RETURNED CHECKS/CHARGEBACKS:** Checks returned by the bank or Credit card chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled according to the following procedure: A \$50 penalty will be assessed for each returned check or chargeback OR 10% of the face value of the check or chargeback, whichever is greater. Accounts will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be reported to the U.S. Equestrian Federation, Inc., PCHA and other appropriate association(s) for further disciplinary action. Checks will not be deposited a second time. In the case that the debt is not cleared within 30 days of the conclusion of the show, all prize money will be forfeited.

**14. UNPAID CHARGES:** Any exhibitor leaving the show with an unpaid balance will be billed for these charges and a \$50 billing fee will be added to the total due. Until these charges are settled, all further entries of rider and owner will be returned.

**15. SAFETY REGULATIONS:** Unauthorized use of the light fixtures will result in removal of your appliance. Smoking or open flame devices are not permitted within the stables. Keep flammable decorations to a minimum. Electrical outlets are provided.

**16. CLOSED RINGS:** Horses are not permitted in any ring where a course is set unless otherwise given permission from management, or when there is equipment in the ring. Please check with the show office for information regarding schooling policies. Horses and riders must yield immediately for watering and dragging. Violations of the above mentioned rules may be considered cause for elimination from the show.

**17. RING INFORMATION:** All warm up and competitions arenas contain either geotextile or sand footing. Dimensions are:

**Los Angeles Equestrian Center:** Hap Hansen Arena-150' x 300', Equidome-150' x 300', East Ring-135' x 285', Allen Arena East & West-150' x 300'.

**Flintridge Riding Club:** All rings are composed of sand and fiber. The dimensions are estimated at Grand Prix arena-286' x 127', Ring 2-230' length, corners 134', 118' wide. Upper & FRC Ring-150' x 270'.

**18. STABLING:** Stalls and tack rooms will be available for \$300.00 if pre-paid with the Nomination fee by the due date of entries and \$325.00 if payment is not included. Portable stalls of metal and canvas construction, with stall doors under canvas, and dirt flooring. Permanent stalls are wood, with stall doors and dirt flooring. **Only shavings will be permitted for bedding of stalls. Exhibitors may be assessed a disposal fee for anything other than shavings.** However,

we cannot guarantee stabling for post entries, and we recommend that your entries be received before the closing date. The show office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Management reserves the right to limit tack stalls. Hauling in is permitted and will be charged \$75.00 per day. Stall fees are not refundable after the entry closing date.

**19. ROLEX/USEF RANKING LIST:** Please visit [ryegate.com/uset.php](http://ryegate.com/uset.php) Upcoming Classes to determine which classes will be included in the Rolex Computer Ranking List.

**20. FEED AND BEDDING:** Pre-orders and on-site orders must be submitted through [www.westpalmsevents.com](http://www.westpalmsevents.com). (online order) Orders must be made by 11:00am each day for same-day delivery through the website.

**21. TIES:** In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. All other ties will be determined by time taken to complete the first round.

**22. SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Gate Stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF, FEI or appropriate association schooling rules.

**23. NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each competitor which shall be worn clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all MAY be eliminated from the class by the judges.

**24. DOGS:** Dogs and other pets must be confined to the Stable Area. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Stray dogs and dogs in violation will be impounded by Animal Control authorities. Under no circumstances are dogs allowed at the arenas.

**25. VACCINATION INFORMATION:** Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation-licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. The management in consultation with respected veterinarians and local animal health authorities strongly recommend and urge that all horses attending the show follow a two-part West Nile vaccination protocol consisting of a primary vaccination, followed by a booster 3-6 weeks later. Should you have any questions please contact the CDFAC.

**26. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: LA Labor Day:** Stalls will be available at 12:00 noon on Monday, August 30. All stalls must be vacated by Sunday, September 5.

**Flintridge Autumn Classic:** Stalls will be available at 10:00 on Tuesday, September 28. All stalls must be vacated by Sunday, October 3.

**LA Fall Festival:** Stalls will be available at 12:00 noon on Monday, October 4. All stalls must be vacated by Sunday, October 10 unless staying for the second week.

**LA National:** Stalls will be available at 12:00 noon on Monday, October 11. All stalls must be vacated by Sunday, October 17.

**28. PROTEST:** Any USEF member lodging a protest must first deposit \$200 (non-members \$300) payable to West Palms Event Management with the Show Secretary, which sum shall be forfeited to the Horse Show, if same is not sustained. All protests must be in writing, signed by the protester and filed within 48 hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation. A protest may be filed with the Show Manager, the Federation Hearing committee or Show Secretary. If the protest is sustained, the entries standing next in award shall be moved up accordingly. See USEF GR603 and GR603.1.

**29. HELMET RULE:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

**30. DRUG TESTING:** State of California drug testing rules apply. For a copy contact the Show Office.

**31. GOLF CARTS AND BICYCLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**32. PARKING:** Parking allowed in designated areas only. Violators

parked in NO PARKING ZONES and FIRE LANES will be issued citations and/or towed from the premises at the owner's expense. There are Handicap parking areas in the Stable Area and public parking lot.

**33. WASHING HORSES:** Nozzles are required on all hoses to help conserve water.

**34. STALL CLEANING:** Please deposit all manure at the ends of the barn aisles and NOT in the middle or in front of the stalls. **If excessive cleanup is required after departure from the show, there will be a \$500 fee charged. Trainers are encouraged to supervise their staff to avoid this fee.**

**35. TURNOUTS AND LUNGING:** Horses may not be turned-out in arenas at any time. Lunging in designated areas only.

**36. MEDICAL WASTE:** All needles and syringes MUST be deposited in designated disposal containers and not left in stalls or thrown in trash receptacles. Violators will be fined \$75 per needle/syringe. For the first offense the trainer/owner will be notified as well as the appropriate association. The second offense will disqualify the individual and horse and they will be banished from the show with NO REFUND.

**37. POLING:** Poling is prohibited in the State of California. No bamboo or offsets allowed on the Show ground's. Non-compliance will result in elimination from the show.

**38. ORDER OF GO:** There will be a posted order of go in all classes that will be computer generated unless otherwise stated. All jumper classes will run in strict posted order. Any anticipated scheduling conflicts should be brought to the attention of the starters who will advise you on how it will be resolved. Under no circumstances will the Horse Show be interrupted due to a competitor failing to present himself at the gate in a timely manner. Multiple rides must be shown in the correct order. Failure to do so will result in elimination. In hunter classes with double rounds, a posted order will be observed with a rotation of three rounds.

**39. AWARDS PRESENTATIONS:** In all classes, an awards presentation will be made. Riders should be present to accept these awards. A suitable horse should be available for classes where it is required to ride for awards. Riders failing to present themselves for awards presentations will forfeit all prize money. Trophy to First Place, Ribbons through eight place in all hunter and equitation classes, all other classes ribbon to sixth except where otherwise noted.

**40. PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money will be deducted from each account at the show. Prize money checks will also be available at the show once the horse has completed showing. **NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE DEDUCTED/PAID/MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER'S OR PAYEE'S SOCIAL SECURITY/TAX ID NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY FORM.** Any prize money that is to be paid to someone other than the owner listed on the entry blank must be written on the entry blank at the time of entry. Change of payee will not be permitted at the show. The Internal Revenue Service requires 30% of prize money won by foreign exhibitors to be withheld. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and are required to complete a W-8 Certificate of Foreign Status Form. Unless otherwise stated, prize money will be distributed through 6th place as follows- 30%, 22%, 16%, 12%, 10%, 10%. Management reserves the right to adjust the prize money of any class at any time. No prize money will be paid to classes that are run with fewer than 3 entries. Jumper classics require a minimum of 6 entries to be held or they will be combined or cancelled, and may be run with no prize money.

**41. CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION AWARDS:** Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions with 3 classes that fill.

**42. INSURANCE:** All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their animals. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

**43. FOOD:** Food will be served in the food court.

**44. ATTIRE:** Proper attire is required in all rings during competition.

**45. NON-SHOWING HORSES:** Non-Showing horses will pay \$75.00 in addition to standard fees.

**46. SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitution of horses are allowed with the same owner.

**47. NON SMOKING EVENT:** The events included in this prize list are non smoking events in accordance with California State Law SB-977 Tobacco: youth sports events.

**48. MICROCHIP VERIFICATION:** All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered. A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal. All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions, Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

**49. SAFE SPORT VERIFICATION:** As of January 1, 2019 all USEF members 18-years-old and older, with a Competing Membership, must complete SafeSport Training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions. Please see the USEF website at <https://www.usef.org/compete/resources-forms/rulesregulations/safe-sport> for more information. Those who do not complete the training will be ineligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions.

**JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:** To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

**ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements:** Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner hunter class (at the same competition), First Year, Second Year or High Performance Working Hunter at the same competition. Exception - under saddle classes. Adult Amateur Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same competition with fences exceeding 3'3" except Jumper Classes not exceeding 1.25m, Equitation and Medal Classes, and the USHJA National Hunter Derby. An Adult Amateur rider may ride an Amateur Owner Hunter in the A/O Under Saddle Class for an Amateur Owner rider that has more than one horse entered. No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
