

# PCHA CHAMPIONSHIPS

All riders must be current PCHA members. Order of go for Round one will be random. Maximum of 2 horses per rider in all PCHA Championships.

## \$7,500 PCHA 1.0M CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIP

**704. Round 1** (Phase 1) to be held at 1.0m under Table II, Sec. 1.

Open to Low Child/Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations. Any horse and rider combination that competed over 1.15m during the 2022 show season will become ineligible to compete in the championship. Any rider that competes above 1.20m during the 2022 show season will not be eligible for the Championship. Horses may not compete over 1.25m during the week of the show.

**705. Round 2** (Phase 2 & 3) to be held at 1.0m under Table II, Sec. 2 (a).

The top 30 horse/rider combinations from Round 1 will be invited to compete in Round 2. The order will be in reverse order of merit from the placings in Round 1.

### 706. Overall Championship

The overall prize money will first be distributed to the competitors who competed in the Jump off (Phase 3) according to time and faults from phases 1 and 3. After this, the remaining places through twelfth (if any) will be placed according to the total faults and time from Phases 1 and 2. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%

## \$15,000 PCHA 1.10M CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIP

**Winner to receive the "Sir Henry" Perpetual Trophy sponsored by Mr. & Mrs. Robert Buie**

**707. Round 1** (Phase 1) to be held at 1.10m under Table II, Sec. 1.

Open to Child/Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations. Any horse and rider combination that competed over 1.25m during the 2022 show season will become ineligible to compete in the championship. Any rider that competes above 1.30m during the 2022 show season will not be eligible for the Championship. Horses may not compete over 1.30m during the week of the show.

**708. Round 2** (Phase 2 & 3) to be held at 1.10m under Table II, Sec. 2 (a).

The top 30 horse/rider combinations from Round 1 will be invited to compete in Round 2. The order will be in reverse order of merit from the placings in Round 1.

### 709. Overall Championship

The overall prize money will first be distributed to the competitors who competed in the Jump off (Phase 3) according to time and faults from phases 1 and 3. After this, the remaining places through twelfth (if any) will be placed according to the total faults and time from Phases 1 and 2. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%

## \$15,000 PCHA 1.20M JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIP

**Presented by Premier Air Charter**

**710. Round 1** (Phase 1) to be held at 1.20m under Table II, Sec. 1.

Open to Junior/Amateur horse/rider combinations. Any horse and rider combination that competed over 1.35m during the 2022 show season will become ineligible to compete in the championship. Any rider that competes above 1.40m during the 2022 show season will not be eligible for the Championship.

**711. Round 2** (Phase 2 & 3) to be held at 1.20m under Table II, Sec. 2 (a).

The top 30 horse/rider combinations from Round 1 will be invited to compete in Round 2. The order will be in reverse order of merit from the placings in Round 1.

### 712. Overall Championship

The overall prize money will first be distributed to the competitors who competed in the Jump off (Phase 3) according to time and faults from phases 1 and 3. After this, the remaining places through twelfth (if any) will be placed according to the total faults and time from Phases 1 and 2. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%

**713. Round 1** (Phase 1) to be held at 1.30m under Table II, Sec. 1.

**714. Round 2** (Phase 2 & 3) to be held at 1.30m under Table II, Sec. 2 (a).

The top 30 horse/rider combinations from Round 1 will be invited to compete in Round 2. The order will be in reverse order of merit from the placings in Round 1.

### 715. Overall Championship

The overall prize money will first be distributed to the competitors who competed in the Jump off (Phase 3) according to time and faults from phases 1 and 3. After this, the remaining places through twelfth (if any) will be placed according to the total faults and time from Phases 1 and 2.

## 700. \$7,500 PCHA CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP

**Winner to receive the "Nothing To It" Perpetual Trophy sponsored by the Karazissis family in memory of Diana Karazissis**

Open to Child/Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations. All riders must be current PCHA members. All entries will compete in a first round and the top 25 horse/rider combinations compete for the championship in the second round. The order of go for the first round will be a random order. The second round will be in reverse order of points from the first round. Fences 3'. Round 1 and Round 2 scores will be added together and the combination with the highest totals will be the winner. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%
