GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Show begins promptly at 8:00 am. The arenas will be available for hacking (no jumping) after 12:00 pm on Thursday, April 16th. On Friday, April 17th, the GGT Footing Grand Prix Arena and Relation Insurance Main Hunter Arena will be available for ticketed schooling for \$50 per round. Hunter 2 will be open for schooling all day Friday April 17th.
2. Ticketed rounds will be available throughout each show day as needed while the event is running for entered horses. Each horse with a back number may enter at the gate. Please NO JUMPING in the arenas at any other times.
3. Award to winner, ribbons to 8th place, with Championship and Reserve in each division. A rider must show in at least 3 classes in the division to be eligible for the Championship. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if there are less than 2 entries.
4. The Grand Prix Arena is 350' x 220', the Main Hunter Arena is 275' x 165', and the Hunter 2 Arena is 270' x 160'. Arena maintenance shall commence as needed.
5. All riders must wear an ASTM-SEI certified headgear and appropriate attire while mounted. Formal show attire is not required.
6. Food and beverages will be available for sale on premises on Friday through Sunday.
7. There is limited RV parking available, (both 30 amp and 50 amp rigs can be accommodated). RV parking is \$200 and available with a reservation. Please contact the show office if you would like a space.
8. Stalls are available for \$225, horses may not arrive before 10 am on Thursday, April 16th and stalls must be vacated no later than 6pm on Sunday, April 19th. Early arrivals may be available with an approved reservation.
9. All entered horses must pay an office fee of \$50 and an ambulance fee of \$35, haul-ins are available for \$25 per day and all horses that live on-site must pay a \$50 facility fee.
10. All horses must have a back number visible any time they are on the showgrounds
11. Entries will close Monday, April 6th. Any entries received after this point may have a late fee applied. Cancellations after the close of entries will forfeit their deposit.

- 101 North - From San Francisco/Marin: Exit CA-37 toward Napa Vallejo (5.7 mi). Turn left at Lakeville Road (2 mi.). 7600 Lakeville Road is on the left. Follow road to Sonoma Horse Park. At stop sign, turn right.
- 101 South - From Santa Rosa/Petaluma: Exit CA 116 East toward Napa/Sonoma (.2 mi). Turn left at Lakeville Road (9 mi). 7600 Lakeville Road is on the right. Follow road to Sonoma Horse Park. At stop sign, turn right.
- I-80 - Sacramento/East Bay: Exit CA-37 toward Napa (16.3 mi). Turn right at Lakeville Road (2 mi). 7600 Lakeville Road is on the left. Follow road to Sonoma Horse Park. At stop sign, turn right.

TICKETED ROUNDS SCHOOLING

Ticket rounds are 90 seconds each. Riders must pick up a back number from the horse show office, then sign up at the back gate for their rounds. Horses may participate in as many ticketed rounds as they would like. Courses will be posted each morning for the day. In the Grand Prix Arena, jumps may not be changed but horses may jump any flagged jump in the arena in the correct direction. In the Main Hunter Arena, riders may jump all jumps in the arena in any order by heights may not be changed.

SPECIALTY CLASS REGULATIONS

CLASS 201

The Equestrian's Concierge Hunt & Go Hunter Derby will consist of one round at specified division heights of 2'3, 2'6, and 2'9. All heights will be judged and scored together and prizes awarded as one class. Riders will compete over one round of standard hunter jumps of 10 - 12 fences. The first half of the course will be the "classic" section of the course, and the second half will be the "handy" section. Course to be ridden continuously

from classic to handy phases. The top ten riders will return for ribbons and a victory gallop. Prize money is paid in a winner-take-all format in the form of a gift certificate to The Equestrian's Concierge.

CLASS 207

The 2' SHP Mini Hunter Derby will consist of one hunter type round at 2' with fill and no oxers. Riders will compete over one round of standard hunter jumps of 8 - 10 fences. Special ribbons to 8th place will be awarded with prizes available to the top three finishers.

CLASS 202

The SHP Mini Medal (2') will consist of one round at 2' with fill and no oxers. Riders will compete over a medal round with tests included in the course. Tests may include: roll backs, bending lines, trot fences, halts, and other basic equitation tests. Course not to exceed 10 jumps over hunter type fences. Ribbons will be awarded to 8th.

CLASSES 203 - 205

The SHP Medals 2'3, 2'6, and 2'9 will consist of one round at the selected height. Riders will compete over a medal round with tests included in the course. Tests may include: roll backs, bending lines, trot fences, halts, and other basic equitation tests. Course not to exceed 12 jumps over hunter type fences. Ribbons will be awarded to 8th.

CLASSES 2061-2064

The SHP Jumper Classic will consist of one round and a jump-off over standard jumper jumps at specified division heights of .70m, .80m, .90m, or 1.00m. All heights will be judged and scored together and prizes awarded as one classic. Class to be scored under table II.2.b. For .70m and .80m heights, the course will not include combinations. For .90m and 1.00m heights, the course will include at least 1 combination. Standard jumper tack and attire is required. The top ten riders will return for ribbons and a victory gallop. Prize money to be paid in a winner-take-all format.
